

MEMORANDUM

To: Concerned Wisconsin Judges

Re: Degradation of the Integrity of the Wisconsin Judiciary

We encourage you to investigate website www.freemyfather.com, a website hosting over 8,000 visitors to date, and which presents unrefuted facts concerning egregious actions and inaction of the circuit court judge for Iron County, **PATRICK J. MADDEN**. Justice is being perverted and the public's perception of the integrity of the Wisconsin Judiciary is being destroyed by the actions and inaction of this circuit court judge.

Judge Madden's actions and inaction violate federal and state constitution, law, and the Supreme Court's Code of Judicial Conduct. We urge you to read all documentation on this website and comments being posted on the website's Bulletin Board by a concerned community. Unrefuted facts published on this website concern unethical and criminal acts committed by Judge Patrick J. Madden and other officials. These unrefuted facts have stirred tremendous community outrage.

After visiting this website, all judges properly concerned with the Wisconsin Judiciary's reputation, and the public's perception of same, should submit their opinions concerning Judge Patrick J. Madden to the Governor, Attorney General, Judicial Commission, and federal law enforcement.

Just as it shocks each member of the public who investigates this matter, unrefuted facts presented at this website will shock each judge receiving this Memorandum. Each judge has the duty to take appropriate action and the duty to report the matter to appropriate authorities. Actions and inaction of the circuit court judge for Iron County is gravely and severely undermining the public's confidence in the Judiciary, and it is therefore critical that all judges fulfill their duty in this matter. See **SCR 60.04(3)(a)**:

"A judge who receives information indicating a substantial likelihood that another judge has committed a violation of this chapter should take appropriate action. A judge having personal knowledge that another judge has committed a violation of this chapter that raises a substantial question as to the other judge's fitness for office shall inform the appropriate authority."
