

SHERIFF ROBERT BRUNEAU CONTINUES TO VIOLATE WISCONSIN LAW AND CONTINUES ACTING TO CONCEAL EVIDENCE OF CRIME

You would think a sheriff would follow the law and perform required duties of his office, especially a sheriff running for re-election. Well, not Sheriff Bruneau! He believes he is above the law so ignores the duties of his office; continues concealing public records that evidence crime and prosecutor misconduct; continues aiding, abetting, and harboring others who commit crime; and continues obstructing justice in this case. Though he was previously implicated in acts comprising felony misconduct in public office, Mr. Bruneau continues acting in violation of law. Here is how Sheriff Bruneau runs the Iron County Sheriff's Department:

1. Sheriff Bruneau refused to investigate police officer Tim Mieloszyk's unprovoked attacks on citizens in the community. In 1997, Sheriff Bruneau refused to investigate officer Mieloszyk's unprovoked and witnessed attack on Don Miller;
2. When Don repeatedly demanded that the Sheriff's Department investigate officer Mieloszyk, the Sheriff's Department told Don that he'd better 'go away' or would find himself 'in big trouble'. Don did not "go away", and 10-months later did find himself in "big trouble", falsely accused and sent to prison for 42-years;
3. Since his good buddy Sheriff Robert Bruneau protected him from prosecution, as did Judge Madden, officer Mieloszyk then went on to commit other violent unprovoked criminal assaults on other innocent citizens. Because Sheriff Bruneau acts to protect criminals such as Timothy Mieloszyk and Connie Vargovich, officer Mieloszyk was prosecuted by officials from outside of Iron County. Officer Mieloszyk was found guilty of felony assault, fired from his job, but given only probation;
4. When Don was jailed in this case, he told Sheriff Bruneau that he was being falsely accused and told Sheriff Bruneau about phone records and witnesses he must investigate in order to prove that Connie Vargovich's accusations were lies. Sheriff Bruneau refused to investigate. At trial, the Sheriff's Department admitted they did not investigate this case prior to forcing Don into trial. Their insane under oath excuse for this total lack of investigation: "*The investigating officer's shift had ended, so he went home*". No investigation because 'the deputy went home'!! Why didn't other police investigate what Don had told them to investigate, and why was there no investigation anytime over the next *2-months* leading up to trial? This was not neglect on Bruneau's part, it was his part in a criminal conspiracy and he is a party to the crimes of false accusation, false swearing, perjury, destruction of evidence, and obstruction of justice;
5. Don was arrested without a warrant, and per the U.S. Constitution, if holding Don for more than 48-hours, Sheriff Bruneau had the duty to bring Don before a judge for a probable cause hearing. Believing himself above law *and* Constitution, Sheriff Bruneau said 'to hell with that' and did not obtain a probable cause determination within the required 48-hours. He instead waited **384-hours**;

6. In 2002, Don filed a motion for a crime inquiry so he could present a huge amount of evidence proving he was convicted on perjury, false swearing, and fraud. While this petition was pending, Don wrote Sheriff Bruneau and requested copies of public records relating to his arrest and police activities in this case. As custodian of those records, Sheriff Bruneau is required by law to answer those requests by either providing the requested records, or giving a legally sufficient reason why he will not release them. He instead simply ignored the requests. When Don sent him follow up requests, Sheriff Bruneau then marked "Refused, return to sender" on the letters, refusing to even receive statutory records requests, and does this to conceal evidence of crime. Concealing public records is a felony;

7. Showing collusion in their 'good ol' boy' network, Judge Madden then began rejecting all of Don's legal mail he sent to the court. Under the Federal Criminal Code, sections 241 and 242 of Title 18, denying Don's access to the court in such a manner is a federal crime. Under state law, it is felony misconduct in office. Because these actors were violating law, concealing evidence of perjury, and denying access to the court, Don complained to various officials. The good ol' boys then immediately stopped refusing mail. Sheriff Bruneau simply resumed ignoring all letters containing requests for public records that prove perjury and government misconduct; and Judge Madden does not act on any matter submitted to him;

8. To obtain public records needed to prove other counts of perjury and DA Lipske's knowing use of perjury at trial, Don continued making 'open records' requests to Sheriff Bruneau under Chapter 19 of the Wisconsin Statutes. In June 2006, Sheriff Bruneau again resumed his criminal conduct by "refusing" and returning Don's mail containing lawful requests for public records that will prove criminal activity. (The prior refused letters are on this website, and we just posted the latest letter upon which Sheriff Bruneau marked "Refused" and returned to Don on June 8th, 2006);

Folks, Sheriff Robert Bruneau is routinely committing criminal acts and assisting a criminal conspiracy to obstruct justice and harbor criminals, and your tax dollars are paying him to do this! Mr. Bruneau believes he is above the law. So do his pals DA Lipske and Judge Madden. It simply couldn't be any more clear that there *absolutely is* a criminal conspiracy in this case. This is so well proven. The conspirators won't deny it in the face of all the evidence against them. For those of you interested in the laws Sheriff Bruneau violated, go on-line to a law library, or visit a courthouse law library, and look up the following to see what crimes this 'actor' has committed and continues to commit:

- 18 U.S.C. 241 and 18 U.S.C. 242 of the Federal Criminal Code (deprivation of civil rights under color of law and conspiracy to deprive constitutional rights under color of law);
- Wisconsin Statute 946.12 (makes it a felony to act, by commission or omission, contrary to a required duty of one's public office);

- Wisconsin Statute 939.05 (allows felony prosecution of anyone concerned in commission of crime, whether he directly commits the crime, aids or abets its commission, or conspires to commit it, making him liable for an offense committed by another. Further, party to crime is guilty of that crime, whether or not he intended that crime or had intent of its perpetrator);
- Wisconsin Statute 946.47 (makes it a felony to act with intent to prevent apprehension of a criminal; to harbor or aid him or her; or to alter, hide, or disguise any evidence);
- Wisconsin Statute 946.72 (makes it a felony to tamper with public records; or to destroy, damage, remove or conceal any public record).

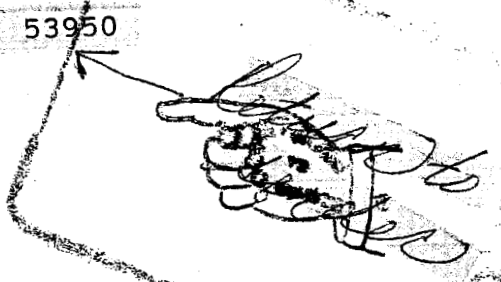
Sheriff Bruneau's core duty is to follow law, investigate crime, and apprehend criminals. This includes crimes of false accusation, false swearing, perjury, and felony misconduct in public office. Sheriff Bruneau refuses to do so. He protected a fellow police officer from prosecution for his violent assaults on members of our community, and when Don complained about assaults against himself and others, he was told to 'go away' or would be in 'big trouble'. Sheriff Bruneau also refused to investigate false police reports and perjury used against Don 10-months later; denied Don's constitutional right to a probable cause hearing within 48-hours of arrest. Mr. Bruneau knew Connie Vargovich was Judge Madden's girlfriend, knew Don was being railroaded, and even dropped hints to Don concerning this, yet did not intervene to protect Don from crime. He instead assisted the criminals. Sheriff Bruneau had possession of a DNA test kit that would exonerate Don, the same kit DA Lipske wanted to destroy *before* trial. The sheriff and DA now claim the kit is 'somehow missing', but they have been caught in many lies concerning this.

Sheriff Bruneau's core duty is to investigate crime, yet refuses to do so to this day. He also has a statutory duty to receive and respond to requests for public documents of which he is custodian. He refuses to do so to this day. He has a duty to arrest police officers who attack our brothers, sons, and fathers. He instead protected the officer, and officials outside of Iron County had to step in to protect our community. I could go on and on, but you see that Robert Bruneau should be criminally prosecuted for multiple crimes. He has violated the law many times, assists others in doing so, and harbors criminals from prosecution. This is quite ironic. Taxpayers support this guy and your tax dollars will support him with a big fat pension all through his retirement years, yet Sheriff Bruneau laughs in our faces by violating the law, protecting criminals, obstructing justice and will put you, your family, and all your friends in his jail at the drop of a hat for any reason, then will allow you and/or them to be railroaded, and he will help them do it to you. Then when you try to prove you were railroaded, he will protect the criminals and ignore the duties of his job. What a guy.

When will the community get tired of **corruption**? Iron County Corruption is a painful pus filled boil. Let's lance it, drain it, and be done with it. Contact Governor Doyle, Attorney General Lautenschlager, FBI, and newspapers. There is an election coming up. Ask your friends and family to cast votes *against* corruption. Let's pull together.

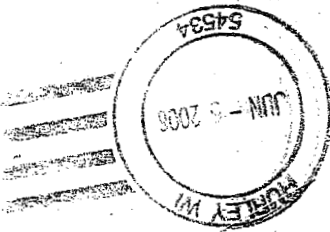
